Q&A

How should you prepare for Family Day?

- Prior to arriving, consider what questions you might have and write them down

What should you expect when you arrive?

- Check-in at Roberts Chapel; please have your ID and offender's GDC number ready
- GDC will have security procedures in place; bring only what is necessary
- Family or significant others must be on the offender's approved visitation list
- GDC will issue color-coded numbers corresponding to the facility's region
- Attendees must remain in Roberts Chapel until number is called
- Once the number is called, groups of 15-20 will be ushered to Vinzant Hall

Physical assistance

- If you need physical assistance, please inform a GDC representative during check-in
- Individuals in need of assistance will be driven in an open-air golf cart to Vinzant Hall by security staff

Recommended attire

- Wear comfortable clothing and shoes, as possibility you will be walking or standing for extended periods of time

Time with GDC representative

- To ensure we can address the concerns of as many individuals as possible, please try to limit your time spent with a GDC representative to 10 minutes, if possible

Those who would like to speak with the Commissioner will be required to sign up for an appointment upon arrival. Scheduling will be based on first come, first serve and appointment times are limited so he can see as many people as possible.
